


ADMINISTRATIVE REMARKS

22OCT2014: On August 25, 2014, you assisted in a rescue of Lawrence and Susan Nelson after their 48 foot boat began taking on water and sank at the St. Johns River South Jetty. Responding in challenging weather conditions that were pushing the operational limitations of the 45 foot Response Boat-Medium, you faced six to eight foot seas, 19 knot winds with gusts to nearly 30 knots in a blinding rain storm. Working in close proximity to the jetties, which were unforgiving and disorienting, you located Lawrence and Susan, plucked them from the seas in the dark night in reduced visibility, and took them safely to shore saving them from peril.

I commend you for your seamanship and determination despite the adverse weather conditions - great job and keep up the good work!

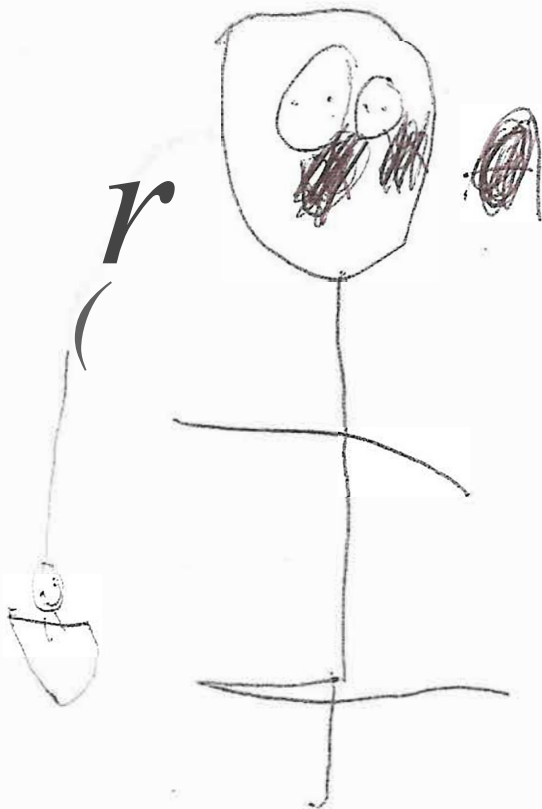
