December 3, 2013, while working the

Brunswick-Glynn Academy basketball game, I

heard unit 025, (Officer Jody Vincent) report on

the police radio that someone had a 10-32

(weapon). I went to the front of the gym to assist

him and heard officers on the radio stating that

the suspect was running towards the rear of the

Brunswick High building. I ran to the back of

the building where Chief Ellis, Investigator

Ricky Hilburn, and Officer Scotty Schultz were

in the process of arresting a B/M that had been

running from them. After the arrest, I proceeded

back to the front of the gym and instructed all

the doors to be locked and not to let anyone

inside the gym or out of the gym till this

incident could be contained. While standing

outside of the front doors of the gym, a B/M

pointed to a location in the grass between the

paved walkways. When I looked towards the

area, I noticed a pistol in the grass just outside

the gym right front doors in the grassy area

between the paved walkways. I went to the

location of the pistol and placed a folding sign

over it to prevent anyone from entering the

location. I contacted Chief Ellis by radio and

advised him the pistol had been located. Chief

Ellis and Officer Hasbrock retrieved the pistol

and placed it in a large envelope for evidence.

approx. 19:30 hrs, I was working my post in the
back of the BHS gym when I heard SRO
Hasbrouck transmitting, via portable radio, that
a black male wearing an orange sweat shirt was
running to the rear of BHS and that the subject
had a weapon. Officer Groover and I responded
to the rear of the BHS gym looking for the
subject. I was asking Officer Groover did he see
the subject and he said no. As soon as I said that,
I heard another officer, Officer Scotty Schultz,
shouting a verbal command, "Stop or I will
shoot you". Upon my arrival to the scene where
I heard the verbal command, Investigator
Hilburn and Officer Scotty Schultz had a subject
on the ground where they detained subject. I
searched subject thoroughly to find the weapon
that the subject was supposed to have on his
person. No such weapon was found. Subject was
asked by me "Where is the weapon?". Subject
stated that he lost the weapon somewhere
around the school, but he could not be specific. I
performed a thorough search in the area where
the subject ran and no weapon could be found
by me. A short time later, I'd say less than a
minute, I heard Officer Donny Foster call Chief
Ellis, via portable radio, and advised Chief Ellis
that the weapon had been found in front of the
gym. I responded to the front of the gym and
stood by the weapon, along with Officer Foster.
Photos of the weapon were taken by Chief Ellis
shortly after I arrived to the area where the
weapon was found and Officer Hasbrouck
secured the weapon and placed in some type of
folder, when the weapon was secured by Officer
Hasbrouck I returned to my normal duties in the

Officer Schultz # 024 On December 3, 2013, at
about 19:30, while working a security detail at
Brunswick High School for the Glynn
Academy-Brunswick High School basketball
game, I stepped outside the north door of the
gym. While at the door, I heard a loud noise at
the south entrance and saw a black male wearing
an orange shirt being chased out of the door by
Officer Vicent #025. Officer Vicent yelled, "he
has a gun," as he tried to grab the suspect who
was able to get out of his grip. As I started
toward the suspect, I saw Officer Harris #016
fall in the gym parking lot. I went to check on
him, as the suspect was out of my sight. Officer
Harris got up and appeared to be ok so I rejoined
the pursuit. I heard Chief Ellis #01 say that the
suspect was going behind the school toward the
new Brunswick High. I walked south-east
toward the new Brunswick High between the
portables and the school building. I saw a black
male wearing an orange shirt, walking north
under the breeze way at the rear, north east,
corner of the school. Using the cover of the
building to hide myself from the suspect, I drew
my service weapon and stepped out from cover
giving loud verbal commands for the suspect to
put his hands where I could see them. Knowing
the suspect had a handgun, I warned him that I
would use lethal force if necessary. I then told
the suspect to lie on the ground, keeping his
hands so that I could see them. The suspect laid
on the ground under the breeze way. Once the
suspect was completely lying prone, I moved in
and placed my knees on his shoulder blade and
the upper part of his back, pinching his left arm

between my knees. Chief Ellis handcuffed the suspect with Investigator Hilburn #02 assisting. Once the suspect was handcuffed, he was stood up and I held him while he was checked for weapons. The suspect continued to say "man, I dont have anything on me," and at one point the suspect stated that he dropped the gun while he was running. Officers looked for the weapon, while Inv. Hilburn and I stayed with the suspect. Officer Foster #017 said, via radio, that he found the gun in front of the gym. As result of this incident, the gym was placed on lock down and no one was allowed into the building. Many officers also had to leave their posts in order to affect the arrest of the suspect. Inv. Hilburn and I transported the suspect to the Glynn County Detention Center where the suspect was identified as Arbery, Ahmud Marquez. Mr. Arbery was informed that he was being charged with Possessing a Weapon on School Grounds, Obstruction of an Officer, and Disruption of a Public School. Nothing futher to report.

I heard an officer give out a description of a black male wearing an orange shirt with a handgun in his waistband trying to enter the gym. Several officers attempted to apprehend the suspect but he fled from their capture. I heard Officer Hasbrouck stated the suspect was running through the school towards the backside of the school. Since I was position on the backside of the gym, I ran out the back doors with the intention of cutting the suspect off. Unfortunately, I did not see the suspect on the backside of the school. Officer Owens and I searched frantically for the suspect. Before long, we heard several officers yelling verbal commands for the suspect to stop. Officers Owens and I ran in the directions of the yelling. When I arrived, I noticed Officer Schultz and Officer Hilburn placing the suspect in handcuffs. Once the suspect was secure, Officer Schultz searched for a weapon. But to no avail, the weapon was not located. The officers then began searching the path the suspect took while trying to elude them. About eight minutes into the search, Officer Foster informed Chief Ellis he found the gun. I was responding to Officer Foster location. As I was responding to the location of the gun, I heard Major Thomas calling over the radio for assistant with another suspect running along the bus road towards the back of the school. I turned around and started heading towards Major Thomas location. When I arrived, I observed Major Thomas and Chief

Ellis out with a black male subject wearing a green shirt with camouflage pants. While I was checking the subject for weapons, Major Thomas was writing down the subjects information from his Georgia Identification Card. The subject was identified as Jariel J. Coleman with the date of birth 06/08/1994. Once Major Thomas had the subjects information and cleared him from any involvement of the foot chase with the SROs, Major Thomas and I released Mr. Coleman. Shortly after releasing Mr. Coleman, I responded to the area where the hand gun was found. As I was arriving on scene, I was asked if I had anything to secure the hand gun in. I went to my patrol vehicle and retrieved a large brown envelope to put the hand gun in. I gave the envelope to Officer Hasbrouck since he already had gloves on. I observed Officer Hasbrouck carefully placing the hand gun in the envelope and transported it to his vehicle. At Officer Hasbroucks vehicle, Officer Hasbrouck removed the hand gun from the envelope to render it safe. Then, Officer Hasbrouck placed the hand gun back into the envelope. On the envelope, Officer Hasbrouck put where the gun was found, the date and time, and his signature. I signed my name and dated on the envelope as well. Officer Hasbrouck then secured the envelope containing the hand gun in his trunk. I went with Officer Hasbrouck to his office in Admin I at Brunswick High School to secure the weapon for safe keeping until Officer Hilburn (evidence technician) could log the evidence into the evidence fault. Afterwards, I returned back to the gym to my original assign duty. There is nothing further to report. 4:13:24 PM NARRATIVE: On 12/03/2013 at approximately 1840 hours, I was on patrol in my vehicle in the parking lot at the Brunswick High School (BHS) Gym during a basketball game. I was radioed, with flash radio traffic, by SRO Zarak Hasbrouck, who advised me that a black male in an orange shirt and jeans was running towards my vehicle and he was armed. I observed the subject and gave chase in my marked unit. As the subject ran south down the sidewalk in front of BHS, I rolled down my window and pulled alongside him with my sidearm drawn, gave him loud commands to stop. He did not stop and as he made eye contact with me, he was patting his waistband while he ran, as if he was searching for something. Fearing he was looking for a weapon, I continued to train my sidearm on him as he ran. He rapidly altered his course and ran East and ducked in between the BHS buildings and ran back toward the construction of the new BHS. I yelled repeated commands to the man to stop while alongside him even with my sidearm pointed at him, yet he still continued to run. I pursued him as he changed direction back North and ran back toward the gym. SRO Scotty Schultz observed the man and converged on the man from the opposite direction, and with his sidearm drawn, commanded the man to stop. Upon realizing he was cornered and had nowhere to run, the man then surrendered, laid down on the ground and he was secured by SRO Schultz and SRO Hilburn while I handcuffed the man. This activity happened within a time frame of about one minute, from the time I first noticed the man running. During the

apprehension, I gave instructions to lock down the gyms entrances, yet allowed the game to continue. After he was secured, I immediately began to look to see if he had discarded the weapon along his intended escape route. When he was being patted down, he was asked if he still had a weapon, he confirmed that he had, yet he had dropped it. We then began an extensive search of the area. After a few moments, SRO Donny Foster radioed me that he had found the weapon and had not disturbed it, but was guarding its location. I responded back around to the front of the BHS gym where the weapon was on the ground approximately 20 ft from the front entrance. SRO Hasbrouck handed me an envelope, and after I photographed the weapon. Hasbrouck, wearing gloves, secured the weapon assisted by me. The man in custody was clearly identified as being the same man that SRO Jody Vicent had first witnessed having the gun in his waistband inside the gym. He was arrested and transported to the Glynn County Detention Center where he was booked in for multiple offenses of state law by SRO Hilburn and Schultz. The firearm he carried was a .380 automatic and was fully loaded in both magazine and chamber. I instructed SRO Hilburn, Glynn County School Police evidence custodian, to turn the weapon over to the Glynn/Brunswick Violent Crimes Task Forces Sgt. Cory Sasser. This was done in order that the weapon be fingerprinted, and a trace on its origin be made by the Federal Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms. SRO Hilburn was further instructed to try and develop leads in this case to try and determine why the man tried to unlawfully enter this venue with a firearm.

Supplemental Sp130370 Inv R. Hilburn On 12/3/13 at approx 18:30 hrs, I was assigned to work the basketball game, at Brunswick High School, located at 3920 Habersham Street, between Glynn Academy and Brunswick High school. I was patrolling the area of the outside parking lots when officers, that were working inside the gym area, alerted the rest of the SROs that a black male, wearing an orange shirt was running towards the parking lot area from inside the gym and was in possession of a gun. Chief Ellis and I were at the front entrance to the school parking lot when I observed the suspect fitting the description run in front of my patrol car. The suspect continued running through the front traffic circle with Chief Ellis in pursuit in his patrol vehicle, along side of him, on his right side. Chief Ellis was giving him verbal commands to stop and the suspect ignored his commands and continued running and turned left in between the main administrative building and the tech wing running toward the rear of the building. I also continued pursuit and turned left onto the bus road area towards the rear of the school, enroute to the new school campus area in an attempt to surround the suspect and/or cut off his escape route. Chief Ellis had continued toward the back area of the school and had visually located the suspect running behind the school. I fell in behind the chiefs vehicle and again I could hear him giving the suspect verbal commands to "Stop!" at least three times, and again the suspect ignored his commands and continued running and finally stopped when Officer Schultz, who was in front of him at gun

point, yelled STOP or Ill shoot you!. The suspect complied with his order and he was verbally ordered to lay face-down with his hands out to the side, he complied with the orders and with cover from me, Chief Ellis and Officer Schultz took the suspect into custody. He was then placed against the side of the Chiefs vehicle where he was searched by Officer Owens, who had responded to assist us, for any type of weapon. There was no weapon recovered from his person during this search. Officer Owens verbally asked him: wheres the gun at? and he (Arbery) replied: I dont know it must have fell out of my pants. I then verbally asked him: What kind of gun is it? and he replied I think it was a .380, I dont know much about guns. Officers Groover, Schultz and I began retracing his path backwards, to see if the weapon could be located on the grounds between the buildings or near the front of the school. At approx 7:45 pm, Officer D. Foster radioed that he had discovered a small semi-automatic weapon in front of the gym in a grassy area between the concrete slab walkways leading to the entrance of the gym. I believe this was the area that the suspect had first encountered officers when he ran from the inside gym area, and Officers' Harris and Smith had attempted to grab him and take him into custody but were injured in the process. Officer Schultz and I escorted the suspect back to the parking lot area and were advised by Chief Ellis to secure him in a vehicle. The suspect was transported to the detention center for booking by Officer Schultz and me. Upon our return to the school, I was advised by Officer Hasbrouck that the weapon was already made safe and secured as evidence in this case. We then waited with the rest of the SROs for the parking lot and gym area to clear monitoring the areas for any signs of further disturbances. I also took photos of Officer Smiths injuries at this time. (Photos to be added

to the case file for reference.) Officer Harris was unavailable for photos due to him being transported to the ER for medical attention. Investigation continues. 12/4/13 09:05 am I received the recovered weapon as evidence in this case from Officer Hasbrouck at Brunswick High school. The weapon was identified as a blue steel semi-automatic, .380cal, made by Big Bear arms containing the serial number 1177017A. The weapon along with one magazine and 9 rounds of ammo were logged in by me under evidence tag# 1346. I was advised by Chief Ellis to transfer the weapon to Glynn County Police Dept(GCPD) and make contact with Sgt. Cory Sasser, so that the weapon could be processed and an ATF firearm check could be done to see if the weapon was stolen. 12/4/13 09:39 am I arrived at GCPD and made contact with Sgt. Sasser and turned over the recovered weapon to him for processing and an ATF background check as requested by Chief Ellis. 12/4/13 11:10 am I secured warrants at the Magistrate Court in reference to this case. Copies of warrants# 13-03225, 03226, 03227 and 03228 to be added to the case file for reference. 12/4/13 11:20 pm I went by the County Detention center (CDC) to see if I could do an interview with suspect Ahmaud Arbery in reference to this case. I was advised by jail Staff that they were in the process of conducting a daily Head count of inmates and that the suspect was unavailable at this date and time. Ill try again later. 12/4/13 2:20 pm I called the Glynn County Detention center to see if I could arrange an interview with the suspect in this case. I was advised by Jail Administration that he had already bonded out of jail. 12/9/13 2:10 pm I called Sgt. Sasser at the Glynn County PD (GCPD) to see if the ATF check had revealed any further information in reference to the recovered weapon. No contact this date and time. I left a message for him to call me back. 12/11/13 09:35

am I received a call from Sgt. Sasser at GCPD and was advised that the ATF check on the recovered weapon yielded negative results due to the weapon serial number being "ground off" and unreadable. Processing the weapon, there were no identifiable latent prints recovered from the weapon this date and time. 12/11/13 10:18 am I received the recovered weapon back from Sgt. 3:57:08 PM NARRATIVE: On 12/03/2013, myself and several other officers were assigned to work the Brunswick High School / Glynn Academy basketball game at Brunswick High. I was stationed on the inside of the gym on the visitors side. Towards the end of the girls varsity game, I went outside and stood in front of the entrance to the gym. After a few minutes, I heard the gym doors on the south side slam open. As I turned, I saw a black male wearing an orange shirt, later identified as Ahmaud Arbery, running out of the door. As he did this, I heard Ofc. Vicent yell "he's got a gun". At this point, the suspect was near Ofc. Smith, who tried to grab him, but he (Arbery) was able to break free and continue running. I began to run after the suspect through the parking lot, as I was running near the suspect, I tripped on a speed bump which caused me to fall and slide across the asphalt, immediately I began to feel immense pain from my right hand, left elbow area and both knees. I then got up and continued running after the suspect losing sight of him near the front of the school. At this point, due to the pain in my hand, I looked down and checked it. I saw my hand bleeding heavily due to the fact that I had severe cuts and abrasions to my right thumb, right ring finger and left pinky finger. I also had a serious abrasion and bleeding on my left elbow area. Seeing the need to stop the bleeding, I returned to the front of the gym, where I retrieved a towel from my patrol car. As I was trying to stop the bleeding, I heard Chief Ellis advise over the radio that the suspect was in custody. I also saw Ofc. Foster standing in the grassy area in front of the gym in the area in

front of the ticket booth. He was standing near a sign with what appeared to be a small handgun that was laying in the grass. After securing the suspect and the gun, Chief Ellis requested one of the athletic trainer check my hand and arm. The trainer cleaned my hand and examined it, he told Chief Ellis that I may need stitches and may have a broken finger. Chief Ellis then had Major Thomas transport me to the emergency room for treatment. Once there my hand, elbow, and both knees were x-rayed. The cuts and abrasions were cleaned and sterilized by hospital staff and my hand was wrapped using a splint to secure my right hand ring finger. I was then referred to an orthopedist. The next day Dr. Dunn examined my hand and told me that my ring finger had hair line fractures and possibly my pinky finger as well. No further information is available at this time. while standing in front of the gym, I heard a
loud noise behind me and as I turned around a
black male ran past me wearing a bright orange
shirt. Officer Jody Vicent came to the door and
yelled stop him he has a 10-32 (gun). As I
turned back around, I saw Officer David Smith
grab at the subject, but the subject swiped at
Officer Smith's hand and kept going into the
parking lot. Officer Ron Harris then started to
run after the subject and I saw Officer Harris fall
down in the parking lot. I then continued to
chase after the subject and called over my radio
to Chief Rod Ellis (who I knew was mobile in
his vehicle) a description of the subject. Chief
Ellis spotted the individual and gave chase in his
vehicle while I followed on foot. I heard Chief
Ellis identify himself and he yelled at the subject
to stop numerous times, but the subject
continued to flee and attempt to elude us. I saw
that Chief Ellis had his weapon drawn, pointed
out the window of his vehicle and I had my
weapon drawn as I followed on foot. The subject
glanced back numerous times and at one point I
saw the subject's hands move to the waist band
of his pants in what appeared to me to be an
effort to locate his gun. I then paused to tell the
custodians to get in the school and lock the
doors and stay there until I told them it was safe
to come out, and then I continued my foot
pursuit of the subject as he ran along the middle
of the school towards the back of the school. I
continued to call out over the radio to the other
officers responding our path of travel. When I
got to the back of the school, I saw that Chief

Ellis and a couple of other SRO's had the subject in custody. When the subject was patted down no weapon was found on the subject, so Officer David Smith and I began backtracking, the path that the subject had run, in search of the weapon. I also called over the radio to the SRO's that were at the Brunswick High School gym to lockdown the gym until we could sort this incident out. While searching the subject's escape path for the gun, I heard Officer Donny Foster call over the radio and say that he had located the gun in the area in front of the gym. I then went to the front of the gym where they were taking pictures of the gun and where it was found. When the pictures were complete, I put on gloves and took possession of the weapon. I then went to the trunk of my car with Officer Marlon Groover and cleared the weapon and placed it in a safe condition. There were eight (8) .380 caliber bullets in the magazine of the gun, and one (1) bullet in the chamber of the gun. The gun was a Big Bear Arms .380 cal-ACP. The serial number was a little difficult to read but it looked like it was 1170 17A, and it was black in color. I then took the weapon, magazine, and bullets to my office where I placed them under lock and key for safety, until I could turn them over to our Chief Investigator Ricky Hilburn. On 12/4/2013, I turned the weapon, magazine, and bullets over to Investigator Ricky Hilburn to hold for court.

and date, I was on duty, in uniform, at the Brunswick High School gymnasium. At this school's athletics function, my assignment was to provide a public safety presence at the gyms interior doorway. The door I was monitoring was on the home team (right) side. It should be noted that this property is owned and operated by the Glynn County Board of Education as a public school, and is located concurrently within the city limits of Brunswick and Glynn County. I was standing just inside the double doors monitoring the flow of traffic up and down the stairs and through the doorway. As I visually scanned a group of people coming into the gym, my eyes were drawn to a black male in an orange shirt. What caught my attention was a piece of black metal protruding from above the area that would be his right front pocket. I observed what I recognized as the back portion (about two inches) of the butt of a pistol sticking out beneath the mans shirt. It was rounded and textured black metal. The weapon appeared to be tucked into the waistband of the mans pants. I told the man to turn this way and motioned to my right. My intent was to keep the weapon and both of his hands in view. He immediately fled toward the main entrance of the gym. I gave chase, once touching the mans arm, but was unable to apprehend him. I stayed approximately 10 to 15 feet behind the suspect as we exited the gym, running down the grassy incline toward the parking lot of the high school. I saw two officers between the suspect and the parking lot. I yelled gun, to alert them to the danger posed by the suspect. The officers joined in the chase,

as we followed the suspect across the parking lot and toward the front of the school adjacent to Habersham Street. I lost visual contact with the suspect as I reached the northwest corner of the school and returned to the gym. Once there, under guidance from Chief Ellis, we closed the gym to incoming traffic. I circled the gym, ensuring that all the exterior doors were locked then returned to the front entrance to maintain security there. As I monitored radio traffic from the other officers involved with the chase, I learned that the suspect had been taken into custody by Officer Shultz and that the weapon had been found in front of the gym and was being monitored by Officer Foster. I moved to Officer Fosters location and examined the weapon visually without disturbing it. The butt of the weapon was the same that I had observed protruding from the suspects waist band. There is nothing further to report at this time.

I was outside the front doors to the Gym facing Habersham St. when I heard the doors to the gym open and saw a black male, wearing an orange shirt, exit the gym, running towards me. Officer Jody Vicent exited behind him and yelled "gun". The black male was running at full speed, so instead of standing in front of him, I moved to the left side of him, with my right arm out to grab him. When I did, he threw his arms up and scratched my right forearm with his nails and got away from me. When he broke free from me, I tried to trip him by kicking at his feet with my right foot. I then gave chase behind him giving loud verbal commands, "Stop Police" but the suspect continued running towards Habersham St. During the chase, I heard radio traffic from Chief Rod Ellis (GCSP) that he was headed towards the rear of BHS. I then changed my direction and proceeded to that area. When I arrived in the area, the suspect was already in custody, but the weapon was not on his person. Officer Hasbrouck and I began to back track to look for the weapon when we heard Officer Donny Foster come over the radio and state that he had located the weapon. I then went back to the Gym and had the trainer for Glynn Academy look at my arm. He cleaned my wounds and bandaged them for me and advised me to have them seen by a Doctor in fear that they may become infected by what could have been under his (offender) nails. On 11/4/2013, I went to the Nurse at Glynn Academy and she advised me that she wanted me to go to the Urgent Care on

St. Simons and have the scratches treated. Since I had a tetanus shot in March of 2013, I did not need one but I was prescribed an antibiotic and some ointment. On the evening of 11/4/2013, my right knee began to ache and started becoming stiff so I put some ice on it. On 11/5/2013, I reported to the nurse at Glynn Academy that although it did not hurt at the time of this incident that my right knee was stiff and felt swollen. (Nothing else follows).

NARRATIVE: The following took place on the above date and time, while working the BHS vs GA basketball game. I was outside the front doors to the Gym facing Habersham St. when I heard the doors to the gym open and saw a black male, wearing an orange shirt, exit the gym, running towards me. Officer Jody Vicent exited behind him and yelled "gun". The black male was running at full speed, so instead of standing in front of him, I moved to the left side of him, with my right arm out to grab him. When I did, he threw his arms up and scratched my right forearm with his nails and got away from me. When he broke free from me, I tried to trip him by kicking at his feet with my right foot. I then gave chase behind him giving loud verbal commands, "Stop Police" but the suspect continued running towards Habersham St.

During the chase, I heard radio traffic from Chief Rod Ellis (GCSP) that he was headed towards the rear of BHS. I then changed my direction and proceeded to that area. When I arrived in the area, the suspect was already in custody, but the weapon was not on his person.

Officer Hasbrouck and I began to back track to look for the weapon when we heard Officer Donny Foster come over the radio and state that he had located the weapon. I then went back to the Gym and had the trainer for Glynn Academy look at my arm. He cleaned my wounds and bandaged them for me and advised me to have them seen by a Doctor in fear that they may become infected by what could have been under his (offender) nails.

On 11/4/2013, I went to the Nurse at Glynn Academy and she advised me that she wanted me to go to the Urgent Care on St. Simons and have the scratches treated. Since I had a tetanus shot in March of 2013, I did not need one but I was prescribed an antibiotic and some ointment.

On the evening of 11/4/2013, my right knee began to ache and started becoming stiff so I put some ice on it.

On 11/5/2013, I reported to the nurse at Glynn Academy that although it did not hurt at the time of this incident that my right knee was stiff and felt swollen. (Nothing else follows).

NARRATIVE: On the listed time and date, I was on duty, in uniform, at the Brunswick High School gymnasium. At this school's athletics function, my assignment was to provide a public safety presence at the gyms interior doorway.

The door I was monitoring was on the home team (right) side. It should be noted that this property is owned and operated by the Glynn County Board of Education as a public school, and is located concurrently within the city limits of Brunswick and Glynn County.

I was standing just inside the double doors monitoring the flow of traffic up and down the stairs and through the doorway. As I visually scanned a group of people coming into the gym, my eyes were drawn to a black male in an orange shirt. What caught my attention was a piece of black metal protruding from above the area that would be his right front pocket. I observed what I recognized as the back portion (about two inches) of the butt of a pistol sticking out beneath the mans shirt. It was rounded and textured black metal. The weapon appeared to be tucked into the waistband of the mans pants.

I told the man to turn this way and motioned to my right. My intent was to keep the weapon and both of his hands in view. He immediately fled toward the main entrance of the gym. I gave chase, once touching the mans arm, but was unable to apprehend him.

I stayed approximately 10 to 15 feet behind the suspect as we exited the gym, running down the grassy incline toward the parking lot of the high school. I saw two officers between the suspect and the parking lot. I yelled gun, to alert them to the danger posed by the suspect. The officers joined in the chase, as we followed the suspect across the parking lot and toward the front of the school adjacent to Habersham Street.

I lost visual contact with the suspect as I reached the northwest corner of the school and returned to the gym. Once there, under guidance from Chief Ellis, we closed the gym to incoming traffic. I circled the gym, ensuring that all the exterior doors were locked then returned to the front entrance to maintain security there.

There is nothing further to report at this time.

NARRATIVE: On 12/3/2013 at about 1930 hours, I (Officer Zarak Hasbrouck) while standing in front of the gym, I heard a loud noise behind me and as I turned around a black male ran past me wearing a bright orange shirt. Officer Jody Vicent came to the door and yelled stop him he has a 10-32 (gun). As I turned back around, I saw Officer David Smith grab at the subject, but the subject swiped at Officer Smith's hand and kept going into the parking lot. Officer Ron Harris then started to run after the subject and I saw Officer Harris fall down in the parking lot. I then continued to chase after the subject and called over my radio to Chief Rod Ellis (who I knew was mobile in his vehicle) a description of the subject. Chief Ellis spotted the individual and gave chase in his vehicle while I followed on foot. I heard Chief Ellis identify himself and he yelled at the subject to stop numerous times, but the subject continued to flee and attempt to elude us. I saw that Chief Ellis had his weapon drawn, pointed out the window of his vehicle and I had my weapon drawn as I followed on foot. The subject glanced back numerous times and at one point I saw the subject's hands move to the waist band of his pants in what appeared to me to be an effort to locate his gun. I then paused to tell the custodians to get in the school and lock the doors and stay there until I told them it was safe to come out, and then I continued my foot pursuit of the subject as he ran along the middle of the school towards the back of the school. I continued to call out over the radio to the other officers responding our path of travel. When I got to the back of the school, I saw that Chief Ellis and and a couple of other SRO's had the subject in custody.

When the subject was patted down no weapon was found on the subject, so Officer David Smith and I began backtracking, the path that the subject had run, in search of the weapon. I also called over the radio to the SRO's that were at the Brunswick High School gym to lockdown the gym until we could sort this

incident out. While searching the subject's escape path for the gun, I heard Officer Donny Foster call over the radio and say that he had located the gun in the area in front of the gym. I then went to the front of the gym where they were taking pictures of the gun and where it was found. When the pictures were complete, I put on gloves and took possession of the weapon. I then went to the trunk of my car with Officer Marlon Groover and cleared the weapon and placed it in a safe condition. There were eight (8) .380 caliber bullets in the magazine of the gun, and one (1) bullet in the chamber of the gun. The gun was a Big Bear Arms .380 cal-ACP. The serial number was a little difficult to read but it looked like it was 1170 17A, and it was black in color. I then took the weapon, magazine, and bullets to my office where I placed them under lock and key for safety, until I could turn them over to our Chief Investigator Ricky Hilburn. On 12/4/2013, I turned the weapon, magazine, and bullets over to Investigator Ricky Hilburn to hold for court. End of statement.

NARRATIVE: On 12/03/2013 at approx. 19:30 hrs, I was working my post in the back of the BHS gym when I heard SRO Hasbrouck transmitting, via portable radio, that a black male wearing an orange sweat shirt was running to the rear of BHS and that the subject had a weapon. Officer Groover and I responded to the rear of the BHS gym looking for the subject. I was asking Officer Groover did he see the subject and he said no. As soon as I said that, I heard another officer, Officer Scotty Schultz, shouting a verbal command, "Stop or I will shoot you". Upon my arrival to the scene where I heard the verbal command, Investigator Hilburn and Officer Scotty Schultz had a subject on the ground where they detained subject. I searched subject thoroughly to find the weapon that the subject was supposed to have on his person. No such weapon was found. Subject was asked by me "Where is the weapon?". Subject stated that he lost the weapon somewhere around the school, but he could not be specific. I performed a thorough search in the area where the subject ran and no weapon could be found by me.

A short time later, I'd say less than a minute, I heard Officer Donny Foster call Chief Ellis, via portable radio, and advised Chief Ellis that the weapon had been found in front of the gym. I responded to the front of the gym and stood by the weapon, along with Officer Foster. Photos of the weapon were taken by Chief Ellis shortly after I arrived to the area where the weapon was found and Officer Hasbrouck secured the weapon and placed in some type of folder, when the weapon was secured by Officer Hasbrouck I returned to my normal duties in the rear of the gym.

On 12/3/13 at approx 18:30 hrs, I was assigned to work the basketball game, at Brunswick High School, located at 3920 Habersham Street, between Glynn Academy and Brunswick High school.

I was patrolling the area of the outside parking lots when officers, that were working inside the gym area, alerted the rest of the SROs that a black male, wearing an orange shirt was running towards the parking lot area from inside the gym and was in possession of a gun.

Chief Ellis and I were at the front entrance to the school parking lot when I observed the suspect fitting the description run in front of my patrol car. The suspect continued running through the front traffic circle with Chief Ellis in pursuit in his patrol vehicle, along side of him, on his right side. Chief Ellis was giving him verbal commands to stop and the suspect ignored his commands and continued running and turned left in between the main administrative building and the tech wing running toward the rear of the building.

I also continued pursuit and turned left onto the bus road area towards the rear of the school, enroute to the new school campus area in an attempt to surround the suspect and/or cut off his escape route. Chief Ellis had continued toward the back area of the school and had visually located the suspect running behind the school. I fell in behind the chiefs vehicle and again I could hear him giving the suspect verbal commands to "Stop!" at least three times, and again the suspect ignored his commands and continued running and finally

stopped when Officer Schultz, who was in front of him at gun point, yelled STOP or Ill shoot you!.

The suspect complied with his order and he was verbally ordered to lay face-down with his hands out to the side, he complied with the orders and with cover from me, Chief Ellis and Officer Schultz took the suspect into custody. He was then placed against the side of the Chiefs vehicle where he was searched by Officer Owens, who had responded to assist us, for any type of weapon. There was no weapon recovered from his person during this search. Officer Owens verbally asked him: wheres the gun at? and he (Arbery) replied: I dont know it must have fell out of my pants. I then verbally asked him: What kind of gun is it? and he replied I think it was a .380, I dont know much about guns. Officers Groover, Schultz and I began retracing his path backwards, to see if the weapon could be located on the grounds between the buildings or near the front of the school.

At approx 7:45 pm, Officer D. Foster radioed that he had discovered a small semi-automatic weapon in front of the gym in a grassy area between the concrete slab walkways leading to the entrance of the gym. I believe this was the area that the suspect had first encountered officers when he ran from the inside gym area, and Officers' Harris and Smith had attempted to grab him and take him into custody but were injured in the process.

Officer Schultz and I escorted the suspect back to the parking lot area and were advised by Chief Ellis to secure him in a vehicle. The suspect was transported to the detention center for booking by Officer Schultz and me. Upon our return to the school, I was advised by Officer Hasbrouck that the weapon was already made safe and secured as evidence in this case.

We then waited with the rest of the SROs for the parking lot and gym area to clear monitoring the areas for any signs of further disturbances. I also took photos of Officer Smiths injuries at this time. (Photos to be added to the case file for reference.) Officer Harris was unavailable for photos due to him being transported to the ER for medical attention. Investigation continues.

I received the recovered weapon as evidence in this case from Officer Hasbrouck at Brunswick High school. The weapon was identified as a blue steel semi-automatic, .380cal, made by Big Bear arms containing the serial number 1177017A. The weapon along with one magazine and 9 rounds of ammo were logged in by me under evidence tag# 1346. I was advised by Chief Ellis to transfer the weapon to Glynn County Police Dept(GCPD) and make contact with Sgt. Cory Sasser, so that the weapon could processed and an ATF firearm check could be done to see if the weapon was stolen.

I arrived at GCPD and made contact with Sgt. Sasser and turned over the recovered weapon to him for processing and an ATF background check as requested by Chief Ellis.

12/4/13 11:10 am

I secured warrants at the Magistrate Court in reference to this case. Copies of warrants# 13-03225, 03226, 03227 and 03228 to be added to the case file for reference.

12/4/13 11:20 pm

I went by the County Detention center (CDC) to see if I could do an interview with suspect Ahmaud Arbery in reference to this case. I was advised by jail Staff that they were in the process of conducting a daily Head count of inmates and that the suspect was unavailable at this date and time. Ill try again later.

12/4/13 2:20 pm

I called the Glynn County Detention center to see if I could arrange an interview with the suspect in this case. I was advised by Jail Administration that he had already bonded out of jail.

12/9/13 2:10 pm

I called Sgt. Sasser at the Glynn County PD (GCPD) to see if the ATF check had revealed any further information in reference to the recovered weapon. No contact this date and time. I left a message for him to call me back.

12/11/13 09:35 am

I received a call from Sgt. Sasser at GCPD and was advised that the ATF check on the recovered weapon yielded negative results due to the weapon serial number being "ground off" and unreadable. Processing the weapon, there were no identifiable latent prints recovered from the weapon this date and time.

12/11/13 10:18 am

I received the recovered weapon back from Sgt. Sasser as evidence in this case and transported it back to the GCSP evidence vault where it will be stored until needed for Court.

NARRATIVE: On 12/03/2013, myself and several other officers were assigned to work the Brunswick High School / Glynn Academy basketball game at Brunswick High. I was stationed on the inside of the gym on the visitors side. Towards the end of the girls varsity game, I went outside and stood in front of the entrance to the gym.

After a few minutes, I heard the gym doors on the south side slam open. As I turned, I saw a black male wearing an orange shirt, later identified as Ahmaud Arbery, running out of the door. As he did this, I heard Ofc. Vicent yell "he's got a gun". At this point, the suspect was near Ofc. Smith, who tried to grab him, but he (Arbery) was able to break free and continue running. I began to run after the suspect through the parking lot, as I was running near the suspect, I tripped on a speed bump which caused me to fall and slide across the asphalt, immediately I began to feel immense pain from my right hand, left elbow area and both knees. I then got up and continued running after the suspect losing sight of him near the front of the school.

At this point, due to the pain in my hand, I looked down and checked it. I saw my hand bleeding heavily due to the fact that I had severe cuts and abrasions to my right thumb, right ring finger and left pinky finger. I also had a serious abrasion and bleeding on my left elbow area. Seeing the need to stop the bleeding, I returned to the front of the gym, where I retrieved a towel from my patrol car. As I was trying to stop the bleeding, I heard Chief Ellis advise over the radio that the suspect was in custody. I also saw Ofc. Foster standing in the grassy area in front of the gym in the area in front of the ticket booth. He was standing near a sign with what appeared to be a small handgun that was laying in the grass.

After securing the suspect and the gun, Chief Ellis requested one of the athletic trainer check my hand and arm. The trainer cleaned my hand and examined it, he told Chief Ellis that I may need stitches and may have a broken finger. Chief Ellis then had Major Thomas transport me to the emergency room for treatment. Once there my hand, elbow, and both knees were x-rayed. The cuts and abrasions were cleaned and sterilized by hospital staff and my hand was wrapped using a splint to secure my right hand ring finger. I was then referred to an orthopedist. The next day Dr. Dunn examined my hand and told me that my ring finger had hair line fractures and possibly my pinky finger as well. No further information is available at this time.

NARRATIVE: On Tuesday night, December 3, 2013, while working the Brunswick-Glynn Academy basketball game, I heard unit 025, (Officer Jody Vincent) report on the police radio that someone had a 10-32 (weapon). I went to the front of the gym to assist him and heard officers on the radio stating that the suspect was running towards the rear of the Brunswick High building. I ran to the back of the building where Chief Ellis, Investigator Ricky Hilburn, and Officer Scotty Schultz were in the process of arresting a B/M that had been running from them.

After the arrest, I proceeded back to the front of the gym and instructed all the doors to be locked and not to let anyone inside the gym or out of the gym till this incident could be contained. While standing outside of the front doors of the gym, a B/M pointed to a location in the grass between the paved walkways. When I looked towards the area, I noticed a pistol in the grass just outside the gym right front doors in the grassy area between the paved walkways. I went to the location of the pistol and placed a folding sign over it to prevent anyone from entering the location. I contacted Chief Ellis by radio and advised him the pistol had been located.

Chief Ellis and Officer Hasbrock retrieved the pistol and placed it in a large envelope for evidence.

NARRATIVE: On December 3, 2013 at approximately 1840 hours, I was on duty at the Brunswick High and Glynn Academy basketball game at Brunswick High School. I heard an officer give out a description of a black male wearing an orange shirt with a handgun in his waistband trying to enter the gym. Several officers attempted to apprehend the suspect but he fled from their capture. I heard Officer Hasbrouck stated the suspect was running through the school towards the backside of the school. Since I was position on the backside of the gym, I ran out the back doors with the intention of cutting the suspect off. Unfortunately, I did not see the suspect on the backside of the school. Officer Owens and I searched frantically for the suspect. Before long, we heard several officers yelling verbal commands for the suspect to stop. Officers Owens and I ran in the directions of the yelling. When I arrived, I noticed Officer Schultz and Officer Hilburn placing the suspect in handcuffs. Once the suspect was secure, Officer Schultz searched for a weapon. But to no avail, the weapon was not located. The officers then began searching the path the suspect took while trying to elude them. About eight minutes into the search, Officer Foster informed Chief Ellis he found the gun. I was responding to Officer Foster location.

As I was responding to the location of the gun, I heard Major Thomas calling over the radio for assistant with another suspect running alone the bus road towards the back of the school.

I turned around and started heading towards Major Thomas location. When I arrived, I observed Major Thomas and Chief Ellis out with a black male subject wearing a green shirt with camouflage pants. While I was checking the subject for weapons, Major Thomas was writing down the subjects information from his Georgia Identification Card. The subject was identified as Jariel J. Coleman with the date of birth 06/08/1994. Once Major Thomas had the subjects information and cleared him from any involvement of the foot chase with the SROs, Major Thomas and I released Mr. Coleman.

Shortly after releasing Mr. Coleman, I responded to the area where the hand gun was found. As I was arriving on scene, I was asked if I had anything to secure the hand gun in. I went to my patrol vehicle and retrieved a large brown envelope to put the hand gun in. I gave the envelope to Officer Hasbrouck since he already had gloves on. I observed Officer Hasbrouck carefully placing the hand gun in the envelope and transported it to his vehicle. At Officer Hasbroucks vehicle, Officer Hasbrouck removed the hand gun from the envelope to render it

safe. Then, Officer Hasbrouck placed the hand gun back into the envelope. On the envelope, Officer Hasbrouck put where the gun was found, the date and time, and his signature. I signed my name and dated on the envelope as well. Officer Hasbrouck then secured the envelope containing the hand gun in his trunk. I went with Officer Hasbrouck to his office in Admin I at Brunswick High School to secure the weapon for safe keeping until Officer Hilburn (evidence technician) could log the evidence into the evidence fault. Afterwards, I returned back to the gym to my original assign duty. There is nothing further to report.

On December 3, 2013, at about 19:30, while working a security detail at Brunswick High School for the Glynn Academy-Brunswick High School basketball game, I stepped outside the north door of the gym.

While at the door, I heard a loud noise at the south entrance and saw a black male wearing an orange shirt being chased out of the door by Officer Vicent #025. Officer Vicent yelled, "he has a gun," as he tried to grab the suspect who was able to get out of his grip. As I started toward the suspect, I saw Officer Harris #016 fall in the gym parking lot. I went to check on him, as the suspect was out of my sight. Officer Harris got up and appeared to be ok so I rejoined the pursuit.

I heard Chief Ellis #01 say that the suspect was going behind the school toward the new Brunswick High. I walked south-east toward the new Brunswick High between the portables and the school building. I saw a black male wearing an orange shirt, walking north under the breeze way at the rear, north east, corner of the school. Using the cover of the building to hide myself from the suspect, I drew my service weapon and stepped out from cover giving loud verbal commands for the suspect to put his hands where I could see them. Knowing the suspect had a handgun, I warned him that I would use lethal force if necessary. I then told the suspect to lie on the ground, keeping his hands so that I could see them. The suspect laid on the ground under the breeze way. Once the suspect was completely lying prone, I moved in and placed my knees on his shoulder blade and the upper part of his back, pinching his left arm between my knees. Chief Ellis handcuffed the suspect with Investigator Hilburn #02 assisting.

Once the suspect was handcuffed, he was stood up and I held him while he was checked for weapons. The suspect continued to say "man, I dont have anything on me," and at one point the suspect stated that he dropped the gun while he was running.

Officers looked for the weapon, while Inv. Hilburn and I stayed with the suspect. Officer Foster #017 said, via radio, that he found the gun in front of the gym.

As result of this incident, the gym was placed on lock down and no one was allowed into the building. Many officers also had to leave their posts in order to affect the arrest of the suspect.

Inv. Hilburn and I transported the suspect to the Glynn County Detention Center where the suspect was identified as Arbery, Ahmud Marquez. Mr. Arbery was informed that he was being charged with Possessing a Weapon on School Grounds, Obstruction of an Officer, and Disruption of a Public School.

NARRATIVE:

On 12/03/2013 at approximately 1840 hours, I was on patrol in my vehicle in the parking lot at the Brunswick High School (BHS) Gym during a basketball game. I was radioed, with flash radio traffic, by SRO Zarak Hasbrouck, who advised me that a black male in an orange shirt and jeans was running towards my vehicle and he was armed. I observed the subject and gave chase in my marked unit. As the subject ran south down the sidewalk in front of BHS, I rolled down my window and pulled alongside him with my sidearm drawn, gave him loud commands to stop. He did not stop and as he made eye contact with me, he was patting his waistband while he ran, as if he was searching for something. Fearing he was looking for a weapon, I continued to train my sidearm on him as he ran. He rapidly altered his course and ran East and ducked in between the BHS buildings and ran back toward the construction of the new BHS. I yelled repeated commands to the man to stop while alongside him even with my sidearm pointed at him, yet he still continued to run. I pursued him as he changed direction back North and ran back toward the gym. SRO Scotty Schultz observed the man and converged on the man from the opposite direction, and with his sidearm drawn, commanded the man to stop. Upon realizing he was cornered and had nowhere to run, the man then surrendered, laid down on the ground and he was secured by SRO Schultz and SRO Hilburn while I handcuffed the man. This activity happened within a time frame of about one minute, from the time I first noticed the man running.

During the apprehension, I gave instructions to lock down the gyms entrances, yet allowed the game to continue. After he was secured, I immediately began to look to see if he had discarded the weapon along his intended escape route. When he was being patted down, he was asked if he still had a weapon, he confirmed that he had, yet he dropped it. We then began an extensive search of the area. After a few moments, SRO Donny Foster radioed me that he had found the weapon

and had not disturbed it, but was guarding its location. I responded back around to the front of the BHS gym where the weapon was on the ground approximately 20 ft from the front entrance. SRO Hasbrouck handed me an envelope, and after I photographed the weapon. Hasbrouck, wearing gloves, secured the weapon assisted by me.

The man in custody was clearly identified as being the same man that SRO Jody Vicent had first witnessed having the gun in his waistband inside the gym. He was arrested and transported to the Glynn County Detention Center where he was booked in for multiple offenses of state law by SRO Hilburn and Schultz. The firearm he carried was a .380 automatic and was fully loaded in both magazine and chamber. I instructed SRO Hilburn, Glynn County School Police evidence custodian, to turn the weapon over to the Glynn/Brunswick Violent Crimes Task Forces Sgt. Cory Sasser. This was done in order that the weapon be fingerprinted, and a trace on its origin be made by the Federal Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms. SRO Hilburn was further instructed to try and develop leads in this case to try and determine why the man tried to unlawfully enter this venue with a firearm.
